Echoing its own transformation (2025–2030), the Centre Pompidou has launched the lecture series "The Museum to Come". This platform for museological exchange aims to explore some of the key challenges facing cultural institutions today : What stance should they take on new media? Environmental issues? Active reinterpretations of art history?

In this session, Glenn Lowry—art historian and Director of the Museum of Modern Art in New York for the past three decades offers a rare and invaluable perspective on his career and his deep understanding of the art world. This public event provides a unique opportunity to reflect on the major transformations MoMA has undergone over the past thirty years, while also outlining the institution's current outlook and future directions.

Lowry will be joined by Laurent Le Bon, President of the Centre Pompidou; Jeanne Brun, Deputy Director of the Musée National d'Art Moderne – Centre Pompidou; and Philippe Régnier, Editorin-Chief of The Art Newspaper (French edition).

The next lecture will take place on September 21 and will feature multidisciplinary artist Wolfgang Tillmans alongside architect, writer, and Columbia University professor Mark Wigley.
