AS PART OF MUTATIONS / CREATIONS 3

While certain artists integrate the living world into their work, Brazilian artist Erika Verzutti (born 1971) sees it as an art form in itself, marrying the principles of generation and indiscipline. The major exhibition dedicated to the artist at the Centre Pompidou from 20 February to 15 April 2019, the first on this scale in Europe, presents a work teeming with evocations of animals and plants, advocating a sensuality that runs counter to Neo-modern, conceptual trends. The show will run alongside the *La Fabrique du Vivant* (*The Fabric of the living*) exhibition, as part of the third edition of the Mutations / Creations cycle.

An original installation designed by the artist occupies the whole area of the gallery space and combines bronze, ceramic, cement and papier mâché sculptures laid out in islands grouping 'families' of works together. 'Tarsila', a tribute to Brazilian surrealist artist Tarsila do Amaral; 'Missionaries'; 'Turtles'; the 'Brasilia' family, a reference to 1960's Brazil, and 'Cemeteries', consisting of rejected and failed sculptures.

These 'families' have no real theme and follow a rule that is not clear. One work often leads to another and appearances can be deceptive; a banana cast becomes an insect, a kiss is shaped from a beetroot and celery, bronze becomes stone and papier mâché turns to rubber.

A monumental new work depicting a swan forms the base for the artist's own sculptures, a sort of mother figure at the heart of this huge tribe. In a more intimate cabinet, Erika Verzutti presents relief murals in bronze or cement, often layered with paint.

The 'Feminist' dimension of Erika Verzutti's sculpture constitutes a crucial element of her work, occasionally inverting genders and playing with the fascination for femininity and all its clichés: curvy buttocks, the reference to make-up and so-called 'sexy' clothing such as the bikini, or the profession of 'call-girl'. Here, again, there is total freedom, provocative and full of playfulness and irony.

Verzutti's work has been exhibited by several major international institutions, such as the 2017 Venice Biennale, *Viva Arte Viva*, with a giant Turtle and 'Animal Cemetery'; the São Paulo Biennale (2016), the New York Sculpture Center (2015), the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum in New York (2014) and the Lyon Biennial (2012).

Decidedly forward-looking, *Mutations / Créations* is the annual creation and innovation laboratory at the Centre Pompidou, exploring the ties between arts, science, engineering and innovation. It brings together artists, engineers, scientists and entrepreneurs, all the stakeholders in the 'sensitive' and the 'intelligible' which shape and infringe upon our present. Following a first edition in 2017 devoted to design and manufacturing trends in 3D printing, a second edition in 2018 exploring the history of digital code and its artistic appropriation since the 1960s, this third edition examines the living and its protocols of (re) creation. At the crossroads between disciplinary fields, *Mutations / Créations 3* summons up visual and digital art, design and speech through a group exhibition, *La Fabrique du Vivant [The Fabric of the living]*, the first European monographic exhibition on Brazilian artist Erika Verzutti, and the third edition of the *Vertigo* forum, organised by the IRCAM Institute.
